





Top 10 Cultural Experiences

Yuchi Township is considered "the home of black tea". Hike the Maolan Mountain Trail or stroll among the tea plantations along Xiang Cha (Fragrant Tea) Lane. Sample locally grown tea and learn how tea leaves are harvested and processed.

There are deep historical connections between Sun Moon Lake and former President Chiang Kai-shek. Representative sites include Hanbi Trail, Cien Pagoda, and Jesus Church.

Puli papermaking culture

Puli is the home of handmade paper and an important center for learning about Taiwan's paper industry.

Jiji railway culture

The Jiji Line is Taiwan's longest single-track railway line and the earliest to be developed for tourism. At the Checheng Railway Sightseeing School, learn about Taiwan's railway history.

Iiii and Shuili ceramic arts culture

Jiji and Shuili townships are two important places in the development of Taiwan's ceramic arts. Snake Kiln and Tian Xing Kiln are well-preserved wood-burning kilns.




Central Taiwan's Pearl

Sun Moon Lake is Taiwan's largest semi-natural lake, shining (a sacred place of the Thao tribe) marks the boundary between the eastern and western sides, which appear like a solar disk and crescent moon, from which this lake gets its name. Here, dreamlike landscapes of mountains, forest, and water are waiting to be discovered. Due to its plentiful water resources, this is also the site of a hydropower plant. All in all, this is an ecological paradise.

The Sun Moon Lake National Scenic Area includes the lake and surrounding Puli Town and Xiny and Shuili townships. Places to visit include Checheng, Formosan Aboriginal Culture Village, Shuishe Great Mountain, Jiji Great Mountain, Mingtan Reservoir, Daguan Power Plant, Jiji, Green Tunnel, Taomi Ecological Village, Stele of Taiwan's Geographic Center, and three indigenous communities: Dili, Shuanglong, and Tannan. 

Tutingzai Hiking Trail 0.6km Highway 21 jia Round-the-Lake Road 9.5-kilometer marker, Tutingzai Parking Lot


TAKRAHAZ Bikeway / Trail 0.6km Starting point is next to the Ita Thao Pier.

- Hanbi Trail 1.5km Starting point is next to the Shuishe Meihe Garden, JesusChurch.
- Toushe Reservoir Eco-Trail 1.6km Highway 21 68.2-kilometer marker, connects to the Toushe Reservoir, Round-the-LakeEcological Path, and Shanlongkeng Suspension Bridge
- Songbolun Hiking Trail 1.2km Highway 21 jia 2-kilometer marker, next to the Wenwu Temple. This was once used by the Thao tribe to transport salt.
- Neihu Mountain Trail 1.5m rom the park behind the Wenwu Temple, take the left fork.

of 1008 meters, it offers views of Sun Moon Lake.

- Wenwu Temple Hiking Trail 0.2km Across from the Wenwu Temple. There are 366 stone steps. On each is carved a day of the year and the names of famous people born on that day.
- Ci'en Pagoda Trail 0.7km bout 200 meters past Xuanzang Temple along Highway 21 jia take the turnoff for the Cien Pagoda. The parking lot is the starting point for this trail.
- Oinglong Mountain Trail 0.85km Xuanguang Temple is the starting point. This trail extends to Xuanzang Temple. Maolan Mountain Hiking Trail 3km
- Next to the Fuli Hot Spring Resort, from the summit are views of Jiufener Mountain and Jiji Dashan. Houijan Mountain Trail 1.2km
- Shuishe Great Mountain Trail 5.6km e entrance is next to the youth activity center restaurant. Reaching an elevation of 2,059 meters, this trail rises 1,300 meters. It is challenging and requires 8 hours to complete round trip. Make sure you have all the necessary
